Sometimes called the Triduum, from sunset on Maundy Thursday through sunset on Easter Day, the Great Three Days are the climax of Lent and a bridge into the Easter Season. These three days: Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday; proclaim the mystery of Jesus Christ's passion, death and resurrection. During these days, we journey with Jesus from the upper room, to the cross, to the tomb, and to the garden. Please use the following prayer throughout the day tomorrow as you await, pray, and hope for the Resurrection.

Merciful and ever-living God, creator of heaven and earth, the crucified body of your Son was laid in the tomb and rested on this holy day. Grant that we may await with him the dawning of the third day and rise in newness of life, through Jesus Christ our Redeemer. Amen.
